



Job Title: Part-Time Packaging Technician

Job Summary: The Part-Time Packaging Technician is an entry-level, part-time, hourly position within the Terrapin Beer Company, LLC Packaging department. Under the direction of Packaging Department management team, is responsible for assisting with the daily packaging operations as detailed below. The incumbent will report directly to the Shift Supervisor.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Must be able to work in a team oriented environment and have excellent communication/interpersonal skills.
- Ability to operate bottling line equipment including pack-on conveyors, bottle rinser and case packer. Ability to operate depalletizer and other canning line machinery.
- Building 12 packs and trays in preparation for placing finished goods in them.
- Ability to operate forklifts and move finished products & materials through the facility as directed to.
- Follow all company policies & procedures, reflect organizational core values and strive to maintain a clean and safe working environment at all times. Practice safe work methods and comply with wearing and using the proper PPE 100% of the time on the floor.
- Ability to frequently reach, twist, stoop, crouch, stand and walk for 8-10 hour shifts. Must be able to lift 50lbs repeatedly and maneuver up to 175lb kegs.
- Perform loading and unloading of bottling and kegging components from the packaging & canning lines.
- Possess basic mechanical abilities with problem solving/troubleshooting skills.
- Comfortable working with chemicals of varying composition and maintaining adherence to safety standards at all times during routine cleaning of Packaging equipment.
- Work in a loud production environment and flexibility to work days, nights and weekends as necessary.

- Work overtime as needed which may require 12 hour days, weekends, and holidays
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Competencies:

To perform the job successfully, an individual should demonstrate the following competencies to perform the essential functions of this position.

- Problem Solving—the individual identifies and resolves problems in a timely manner, gathers and analyzes information skillfully.
- Quality Control—the individual demonstrates accuracy and thoroughness, monitors own work to ensure quality and applies feedback to improve performance.
- Quantity—meets productivity standards and completes work in a timely manner.
- Adaptability—the individual adapts to changes in the work environment, manages competing demands and is able to deal with frequent change, delays or unexpected events.
- Dependability—the individual is consistently at work and on time, follows instructions, responds to management direction and solicits feedback to improve performance.
- Safety & Security—the individual observes safety and security procedures and uses equipment and materials properly.

Knowledge & Skills Requirements:

The ideal candidate would have prior work experience in the brewing or beverage industry in a Packaging job role. Or work experience in a fast paced shipping, manufacturing or similar work setting. Completion of a High School Diploma or G.E.D.

Secondary education via a technical college in the fields of Industrial Systems, Manufacturing Operations Technology, Engineering Technology, Electrical Systems Technology or similar degree programs is preferred.

Additional preferred qualifications would entail previous work experience with filters, labelers, packers, sealers, experience in operating a forklift, CIP experience, good mechanical skills and understanding of machinery and a willingness to work on the packaging lines as a part of the packaging team. A passion for, and working knowledge of, the brewing process is preferred.

Applicants must be 21 years of age or older. This part-time position is not to exceed 29 hours per week.
